PETER HOCKEN HIS FINAL CONTRIBUTION

A week before he died he delivered a great contribution to the Charismatic Renewal by presenting the history of the new dialogue about *reconciliation between the Roman Catholic Church and Messianic Jews* who believe in Jesus as their Messiah. As Fr. Peter said: The Messianic Jewish movement, a charismatic renewal among Jews, was born in the summer of 1967 in California. They have a golden jubilee, just like CCR. Fr. Peter gave his presentation in Rome at the Urbania University, on the 2nd of June 2017 as part of the official program of the Golden Jubilee of the Catholic Charismatic Renewal.
