
Deacon Pancho emphasized what has always been the basis of Charismatic renewal and what the Church also says in its doctrinal documents: Baptism in the Spirit is not a special spirituality for "charismatics." The fire of the Spirit in our hearts is fundamental to the Church [ref: The booklet FANNING THE FLAME]. The sacramental and charismatic dimensions of the Church are not opposed to each other, but are integrated into a whole [ref: Document of the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith, Iuvenescit Ecclesia]. Deacon Pancho has spoken about this in various contexts, including meetings with priests and deacons in the diocese. Everyone, including priests and deacons, needs to get the fire of the Spirit.
